Scroll down to 2016 AERA Annual Meeting and click on 'Online Program Portal'. Underneath the Submitter Menu, click on 'Read your Reviews'. The AERA meeting offers a number of session formats to feature high quality research and scholarly work. Your paper has been placed in a Roundtable Session session titled, "Curriculum and Instruction in the Teacher Evaluation Era". Each format involves different expectations about the mode of presentation. The program schedule, which will include information on the date, time, and location of your session, will be available mid-February. Sessions will be scheduled throughout the entire meeting and your session may be the first timeslot on the first day of the meeting or the last timeslot on the last day of the meeting. Keep in mind that the first session timeslot begins at 12:00pm on April 8 and the last session time slot is 2:15pm — 3:45pm on April 12, so if you plan to book your flight before the schedule is released, please take that into consideration.
